


## Ring size guide

## Option 1

Print this sheet on a A4 paper, without resizing the document and making sure it's on a 1:1 scale. To double check the scale is correct, measure the below bar and make sure it fits exactly 10 cm.

Take a ring that perfectly fits your finger (preferably round and thin) and place it over the correct sized circle. You should only see the coloured circle, with no gaps. If you are in between two sizes, we would suggest to choose the larger one.



## Option 2

Measure the circumference of the chosen finger with a tape measure or a piece of string. Make sure it's not too tight: it has to perfectly adhere to the finger but comfortably. If your knuckles are bigger, take two measures: first on the knuckle, which is the widest part of the finger where the ring will need to pass, and then on the base of the finger. Choose a size in between the two ones.

Please remember that your fingers and your hands are not perfectly identical, so we suggest you measure the finger you have chosen to wear your ring on. It is also better to measure your finger at the end of the day. Once you have a measurement, compare it with the below chart
